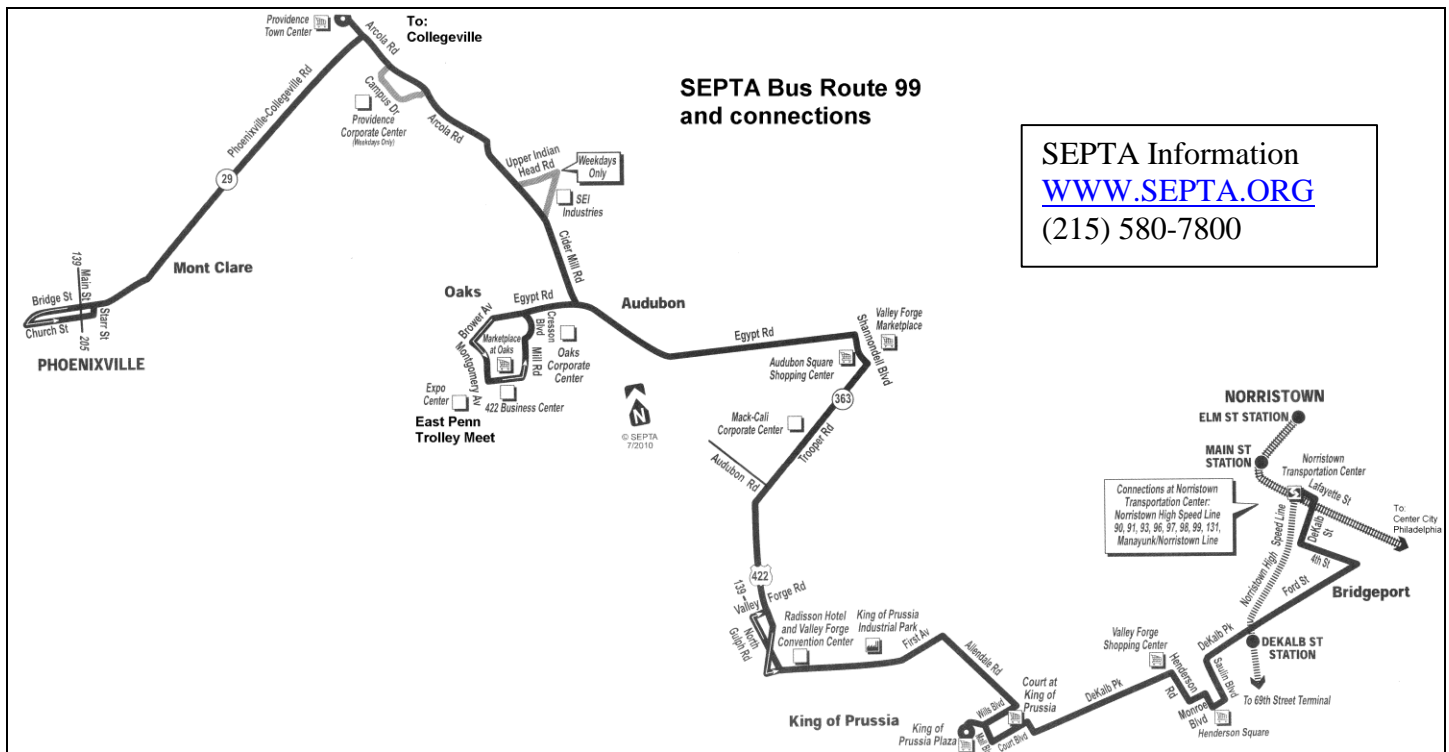
In the same complex as the EXPO Center at Oaks there is a Regal Cinema, a Lowe’s Home Improvement Center, a Target and Arnold’s Family Fun Center with over 144,000 square feet of action-packed indoor activities and adventure for kids of all ages! Go-karts, rides, arcade games, laser tag, bounce, bowling, mini golf, delicious food, and great prizes.

The nearby **King of Prussia Mall** is the largest shopping mall on the East Coast and the largest shopping mall in the US in terms of leasable retail space and the two-building (Court & Plaza/Pavilion) conglomeration is also arguably America’s largest shopping complex at one location. In addition to the many department and high end apparel stores there is an Apple store as well as a Sony store. Adjacent highways have a number of “big box” stores such as Best Buy and Costco.

In Audubon, the Valley Forge Marketplace at Trooper and Egypt Roads has a Home Depot and Walmart, the Audubon Village Shopping Center at Egypt and Pawlings Roads has a Genuardi’s Market and the Audubon Square Shopping Center also at Trooper and Egypt Roads has a Giant Market.

In Collegeville the Providence Town Center at Routes 422 & 29 has a Wegmans Market, Best Buy, Staples, Michaels Craft, PNC Bank and other retailers.
