Dear Friend,

The 27th NATIONAL TROLLEY MEET sponsored by the East Penn Traction Club of Philadelphia will be held Friday May 16th and Saturday May 17th, 2025. The East Penn National Trolley Meets are recognized as the largest event in the country dedicated to trolleys and all forms of electric railways – streetcars, trams, subways, elevated lines, light rail, heavy rail commuter lines & electrified railroads. We invite you to participate in this upcoming event. This event will be in our traditional spring timeframe. The theme of the meet will be "Contemporary Light Rail Vehicles & Trolleys." This can be defined as electric railway vehicles that are post 1976 original construction.

The 2023 Meet will utilize the same exhibit space at the Allentown Fairgrounds Agri-Plex Charles Hall at 17th & Chew Streets, Allentown PA (<u>www.allentownfairpa.org</u>) as our 2017, 2019, 2021 & 2023 meets. Free parking is on site.

Because of various factors, we are not reserving a block of rooms in any one hotel. We encourage attendees to make their own arrangements and check the availability of such matters as on-site transportation to and from the Meet. We leave it to you to decide what other amenities you want in your lodging: breakfast, pool, bar, etc. and we suggest utilizing facilities to the immediate west of the Fairgrounds in the west end of Allentown.

Listed below are some of the lodging facilities in the area:

In the Breinigsville-Folgelsville area are the Hilton Garden Inn at 230 Sycamore Rd, 18031 (610) 398-6686, the Comfort Inn at 7625 Imperial Way 18106 (610) 391-0344, the Delta Hotels by Marriott at 7736 Adrienne Dr, 18031 (610) 391-1000, Hyatt House at 621 Grange Rd. 18106 (484) 229-3004, Staybridge Suites at 327 Starr Rd. 18106 (610) 841-5100 and several others.

The Floor Plan for the 2025 27th National Trolley Meet is attached. The layout of tables is nearly identical to the previous meets at this location. Those of you who attended then will be familiar with the layout of the room.

Floor plan highlights:

• There are planned three-foot access breaks in the long line of tables every three tables. These can be moved slightly to accommodate one dealer having more than three adjacent tables.

• There are additional power drops making power available for all tables. The physical layout of the room, or more precisely the roof and overhead of the room, prevent us from having power drops more centrally located in the dealer rows. But there are more than enough outlets in each drop to accommodate all dealers. Just bring a long extension cord. Bottom line: Everyone has AC power access.

ORDERING TABLES:

OPTION 1: PICK YOUR OWN TABLE - \$45 each

Through March 31 or until 33 tables are sold, you can pick your exact table location. This is much like selecting your exact seat on your flight using online reservations. You can coordinate with your usually favorite neighbors to insure that you have adjacent tables and your prime spot. Tables will be assigned based upon first payment received. In case of a tie, a coin toss will determine the order. To use this option, indicate on the enclosed order form in the Option 1 Section your First and (optionally) Second preference for location (e.g. First: A3-A6, Second A8-A11).

OPTION 2: TRADITIONAL BEST FIT - \$40 each

Option 2 is the usual method we have used to assign dealer tables. You provide your preferences: end table, tables next to so and so, etc. And we will do our best to accommodate your wishes. We do a pretty good job making most folks happy but, like at weddings, you can't always make everyone happy. Whatever option our dealers select, we assure them that we welcome their participation!

OTHER INFORMATION:

• Thursday May 15th is a setup day until 10 PM. We prefer that layouts setup first so that we do not have vans, pickups and trailers full of modules backing in past dealers with their wares spread out. Dealers are welcome to set up on the 15th starting at 11 AM, but please be aware that the earlier you arrive the more interference might be encountered from layout exhibitors.

• Additional dealer setup will be Friday morning from 8 AM until 10:30 AM.

DEALERS SHOULD PICK UP THEIR CREDENTIALS PRIOR TO THE MEET OPENING AT 11AM

FRIDAY. Dealer registration will be at the rear of the room by the dealer entrance and rollup door all day Thursday and Friday before 10:30 AM. Further dealer setup will be Saturday morning from 6 AM until 8 AM for those dealers unable to arrive Thursday or Friday.

• ONCE THE MEET IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC, SECURITY REQUIRES ALL PERSONNEL IN THE ROOM WEAR A BADGE. YOU WILL BE CHALLENGED.

• DEALERS MUST LOAD AND UNLOAD THROUGH THE REAR DOORS. THERE IS NO DEALER LOADING OR UNLOADING ALLOWED THROUGH THE FRONT DOOR. THIS IS AN AGRIPLEX RULE AND IS ENFORCED.

• Trailers can be parked and left overnight in the parking lot.

• There is overnight security on duty Thursday and Friday nights.

• The Meet closes at 10 PM Saturday night and the hall must be fully vacated at midnight. Dealers are encouraged to refrain from tearing down excessively early so that attendees who arrive in the late afternoon of Saturday have the opportunity to visit all of the dealers.

• There is no formal clinic area for this Meet. Clinics will be held at layout-side for 15 - 30 minutes. Dealers wishing to demonstrate a particular product or procedure can arrange to have their demonstration scheduled and announced as part of the clinics. A flashing blue light, *a la* Kmart, will mark the spot of the clinic or demonstration.

• Please consider an **OPTIONAL** donation to our silent auction.

• We plan to have a Dealer Directory, both as a hand-out and on the eastpenn.org website. Please indicate the name to be used on the Dealer Directory on the Registration and Order Form.

The Pennsylvania sales tax rate is six percent. Clothing sales are exempt from sales tax. We have a sales tax promoter license Account ID: 10023793, which should allow out of state dealers to utilize a Transient Vendor Certificate without providing a security deposit.
